

This print is a museum quality, gallery acceptable, archival giclée print. This is a term often abused and misunderstood. Some regular ink jet prints are claimed to be giclée, but do not meet the strict standards, set by the Giclée Printer's Association, that this print does. This print is produced on an Epson 10000 archival pigment printer. This printer is recognized and approved as "Tru Giclée" by the Giclée Printer's Association, as are the Epson archival pigments used. Testing by the Wilhelm Imaging Research, a very respected, reliable, independent testing organization, confirms longevity of well over a hundred years. A very high resolution Creo Scitex scanner is used to copy the original work, also meeting the high standards of the GPA. This print, therefore, is a true archival giclée print, suitable for collection, sale or display in galleries, museums or your home, and will not fade or smear, as is common in regular ink jet prints.
